Benefits and Features

- Trenitalia Domestic trains are non-smoking, air conditioned and have power outlets at seats. Most day trains have a lounge/cafe car.
- Train Types: Frecciarossa trains run on high speed lines with exclusive WiFi, online entertainment portal and 4 classes of service. Frecciargento tilting trains run on high speed and conventional tracks with WiFi and online entertainment portal. Frecciabianca, Intercity, Regional and Night Trains run on conventional tracks.

Accommodations

Frecciarossa

- Frecciarossa Executive: 8 reclining leather seats with adjustable foot and head rest, power outlets, meeting area with table, 6 seats and a 32" HD monitor that can be connected to a PC for video projections. Access to Frecciapub lounges, open bar with selected drinks and meal appropriate to the time of day served at your seat.
- Frecciarossa Business: Reclining leather seats and leg rests in a 2-1 configuration, power outlets, quiet zone and salotto seating available. Welcome drink, sweet or savory snack and in the morning, a choice of newspaper, included in the price.
- Frecciarossa Premium: Equal to a second class plus service. Reclining leather seats in a 2-2 configuration, power outlets. Welcome drink, sweet or savory snack and in the morning, a choice of newspaper, included in the price.
- Frecciarossa Standard: Reclining fabric seats in a 2-2 configuration, power outlets, trolley car service is available to purchase food and beverages.
- Restaurant or Bistro Car: Where travelers can purchase hot and cold meals, sandwiches, salads, yogurt, fruit, hot and cold drinks
- Services for the disabled: Trenitalia offers customers with mobility difficulties a special assistance service in Italy's main railway stations.

Frecciargento

- First class: Reclining leather seats in a 2-1 configuration, power outlets. Welcome drink, sweet or savory snack and in the morning, a choice of newspaper, included in the price.



- Second class: Reclining seats in a 2-2 configuration, power outlets.
- Bar car: Where travelers can purchase hot and cold dishes, as well as snacks, rolls, coffee.
- WiFi not available between Caserta-Lecce and Salerno-Reggio Calabria

Frecciabianca

- First class: Reclining seats in a 2-1 configuration, power outlets. Between Turin/Milan – Venice/Trieste routes only: a welcome drink, sweet or savory snack, and, in the morning, a newspaper, included in the price.
- Second class: Reclining seats in a 2-2 configuration, power outlets.
- Bar car: Where travelers can purchase hot and cold dishes, as well as snacks, rolls, coffee.

InterCity/Regional

- First class: Reclining seats in a 2-1 configuration, power outlets.
- Second class: Reclining Seats in a 2-2 configuration, power outlets.
- Not all Regional trains will offer 1st class. Regional train tickets are valid for 2 months from purchase date.
- Reservations are not required for regional trains.

Night Trains (Bologna - Lecce, Milano – Naples)

- Singles, doubles and triples feature cabins with washbasin, power outlets, toiletries, complimentary mineral water and morning wake-up service, hot or cold beverage, snack and newspaper. Mens and ladies room located at end of the car.
- All cabins are air-conditioned and equipped with locking doors and toiletry items.
- Also available: Couchettes (T4 and T6) and Seats

Conditions of Use

- Advance booking: Trenitalia Domestic trains can be booked up to 120 days in advance.
- WiFi access via SMS text and 1 cent EUR charge payable per train.
- Tickets can be issued as paper tickets and print-at-home e-tickets.
- Name and passport number are required at time of purchase and boarding. Traveler's name must match the passport. This is strictly enforced as of 01 January 2017.

Refund Policy

- Special cancellation fees apply to some fares. Exchange and refund policies vary depending on the type of fare purchased.
- Exchange for paper tickets can only be performed by Rail Europe. To exchange a ticket, a new ticket must be issued and the unused one sent back to Rail Europe for a refund within the time frame allowed for such refund. A handling and/or processing fee will apply. Refund amount based on the refund policy of the ticket being returned, less any fees.

- Exchanges for e-tickets can only be performed at the train station in Italy. Customers can use the self-service machine by choosing “Print & Change” option. PNR and Booking Change Code (CP code), must be entered, both of which can be found on the printed ticket/receipt. Exchanges are also possible at the ticket window.
- Lost or stolen tickets may be protected with the purchase of Rail Protection Plan™.
- Refunds/exchanges are subject to an administrative fee. Refer to Fees/Handling Fees Product Fact Sheet.

Packaging Instructions

- Trenitalia Domestic paper tickets must be stapled in a Rail Europe ticket cover, not an All Aboard ticket cover
- E-Tickets are “ticketless”, only the PNR is required. Tickets can be printed for documentation.

Fare Range

- Issued as combined ticket and reservation.

Base*/Leisure Adult	Unrestricted fare (paper & e-ticket)
Base*/Leisure Child	under 15 on travel date – Free if under 4 (no seat required) (paper & e-ticket)
Economy/ Super Economy*	No advance purchase required, based on availability (e-ticket only)
Passholder	For holders of any pass that includes Italy (paper & e-ticket)
Group Adult	Minimum 10 pax (paper only)
Group Child	Minimum 10 pax – Under 15 on train's departure date (paper only)
